Dear Grade Four Families,

As our school community continues to grow, Nose Creek School has had to team up students in certain grades to share a locker. The Grade four students will be sharing a locker with a peer this year, which creates an opportunity for the students to work together to keep a common area clean and organized.

Please take a moment to read over the following guidelines with your child regarding proper locker use and habits.

o The school assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal or school items in a locked or unlocked locker. Please leave toys, stuffies, technology etc. at home unless a teacher asked for them to be brought in. Please bring only items needed for learning at Nose Creek School.

o No food is to be left in the lockers overnight or over the weekend. If you do not eat your lunch, you need to take it home to be composted or re-used.

o Students are in charge of keeping their combinations a secret. Only the student, their partner and the teacher should know the locker combination.

o If a disagreement occurs between you and your locker partner, the first step is to talk to them about how to solve the problem and then talking to a teacher about what is working and what is not working.
